



SMS commands for remotely controlling Dr.Web Anti-theft

Send the trusted friends on your Dr.Web Anti-theft contact list a memo containing the SMS commands used to remotely control the Anti-theft in emergency situations—that way they'll know how to help you when needed.

Do your friends also use Dr.Web Anti-theft? Save the memo for yourself as well—maybe your friends will need your help.

All commands are case-insensitive.

Command	What will happen?
#LOCK#Password#	The device will be blocked.
#SIGNAL# Password#	The device will be blocked, and a siren will be turned on.
#LOCATE# Password#	The device's GPS coordinates will be sent in a reply SMS message.
#WIPE# Password#	Data will be removed from the device's memory, and the device will be reset to factory settings.
#UNLOCK# Password#	The device will be unlocked, and the Anti-theft password will not be reset.
#RESETPASSWORD#	The device will be unlocked, and the Anti-theft password will be reset. ! This command can be sent only from a phone number that has been added to the Buddies list.
